

Instructions for dressing Occibraies

Tools required :

- Clothes pegs or paper clips
- Hammer (for riveting)
- Wooden mandrel (tool for setting the rivet)
- A little patience
- A friendly donkey

NB : It will be much easier with two of us to put the trousers on and adjust them

NB : The front and back trousers are the same shape and size

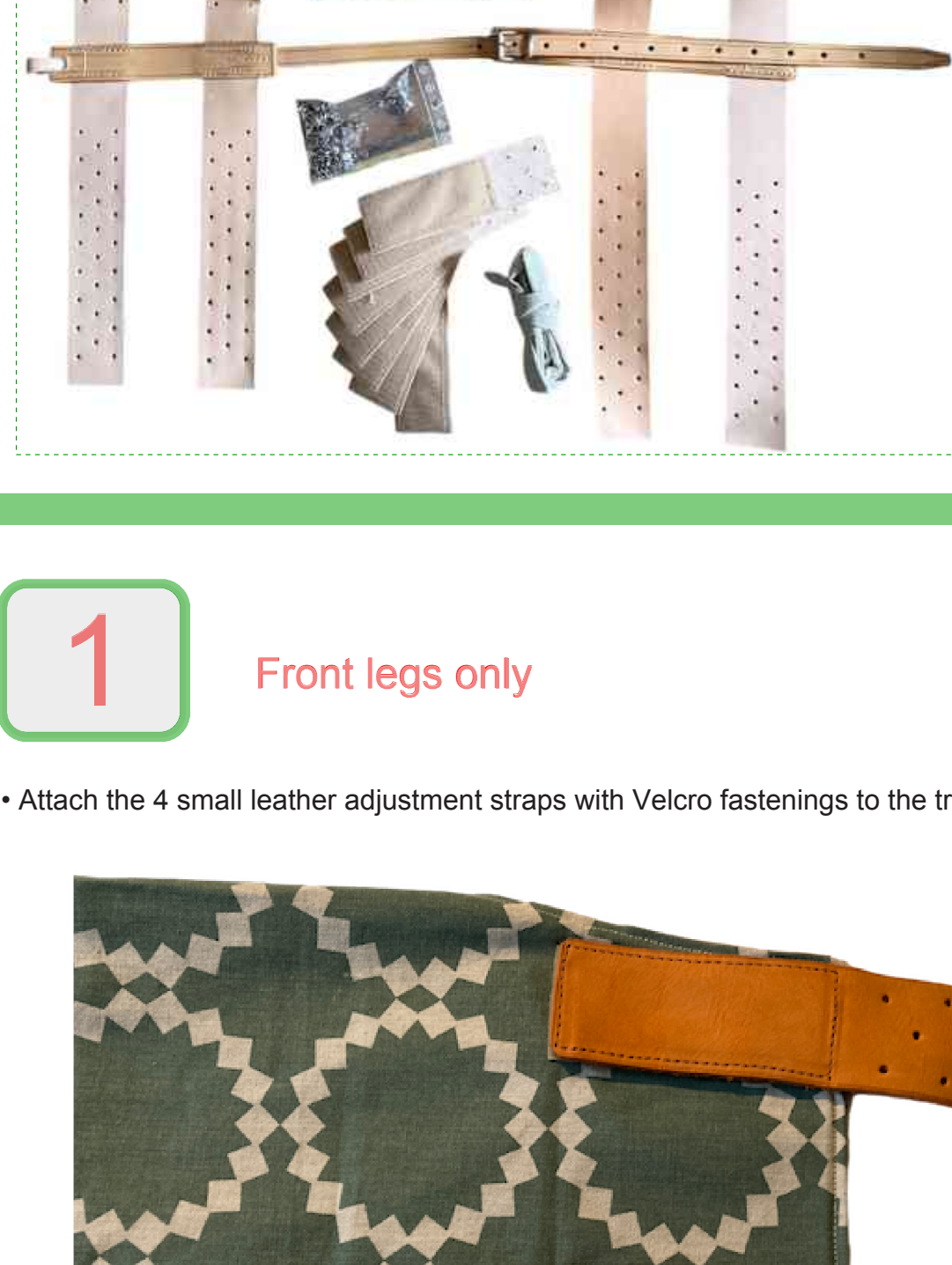
Items supplied with the front leg Occibraies - Go to point 1

- 1 narrow leather back strap with 4 tabs
- 4 small leather adjustment tabs
- 2 trouser legs
- 20 rivets (20 male rivets, 20 female rivets)



Items supplied with the Occibraies rear legs - Go to point 2

- 1 long leather back strap with 4 tabs
- 4 small leather adjustment tabs
- 1 fabric chest strap
- 2 trouser legs
- 20 rivets (20 male rivets, 20 female rivets)



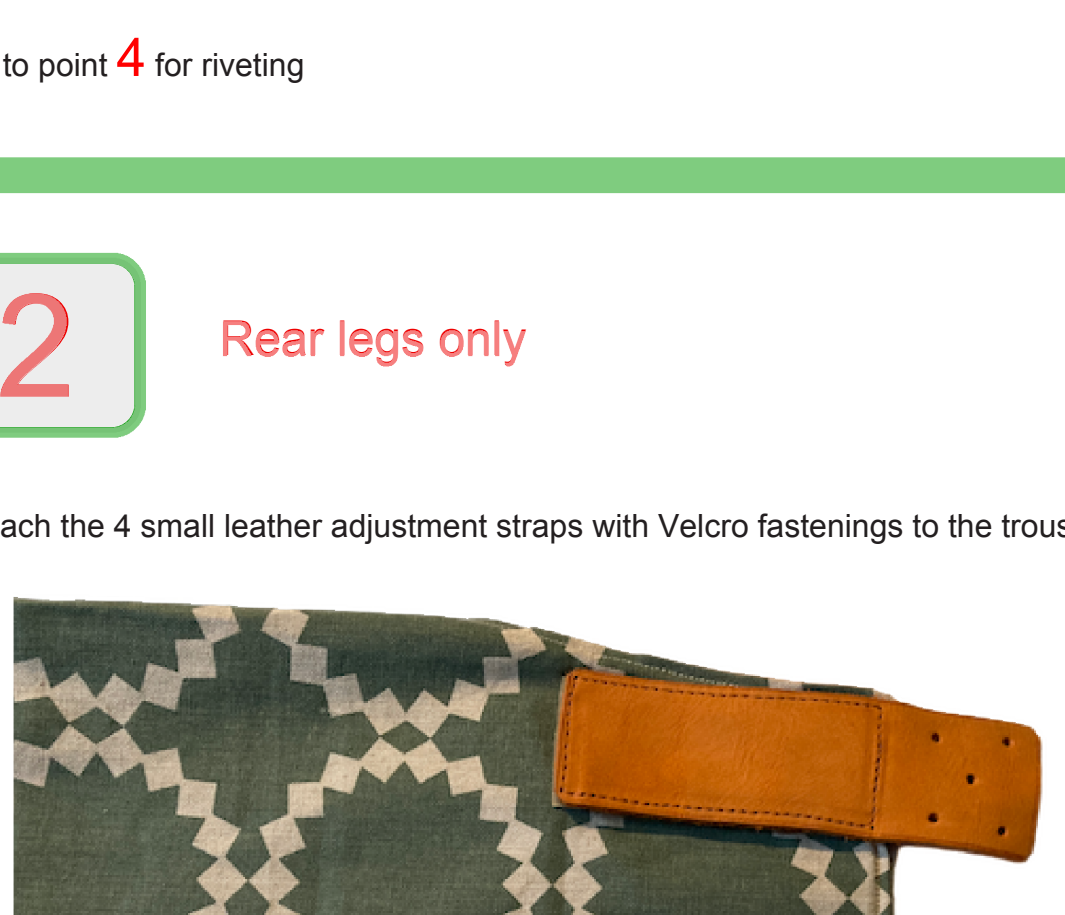
Items supplied with the Occibraies front and rear legs - Go to point 3

- 1 long leather back strap with 8 tabs
- 8 small leather adjustment tabs
- 1 fabric chest strap
- 2 trouser legs
- 40 rivets (40 male rivets, 40 female rivets)



1 Front legs only

- Attach the 4 small leather adjustment straps with Velcro fastenings to the trousers.



- Place the narrow leather back strap and its four leather straps on the animal's back.

- Slip the trousers over the animal's front legs. Secure the small and large leather straps together at the correct height using clips.

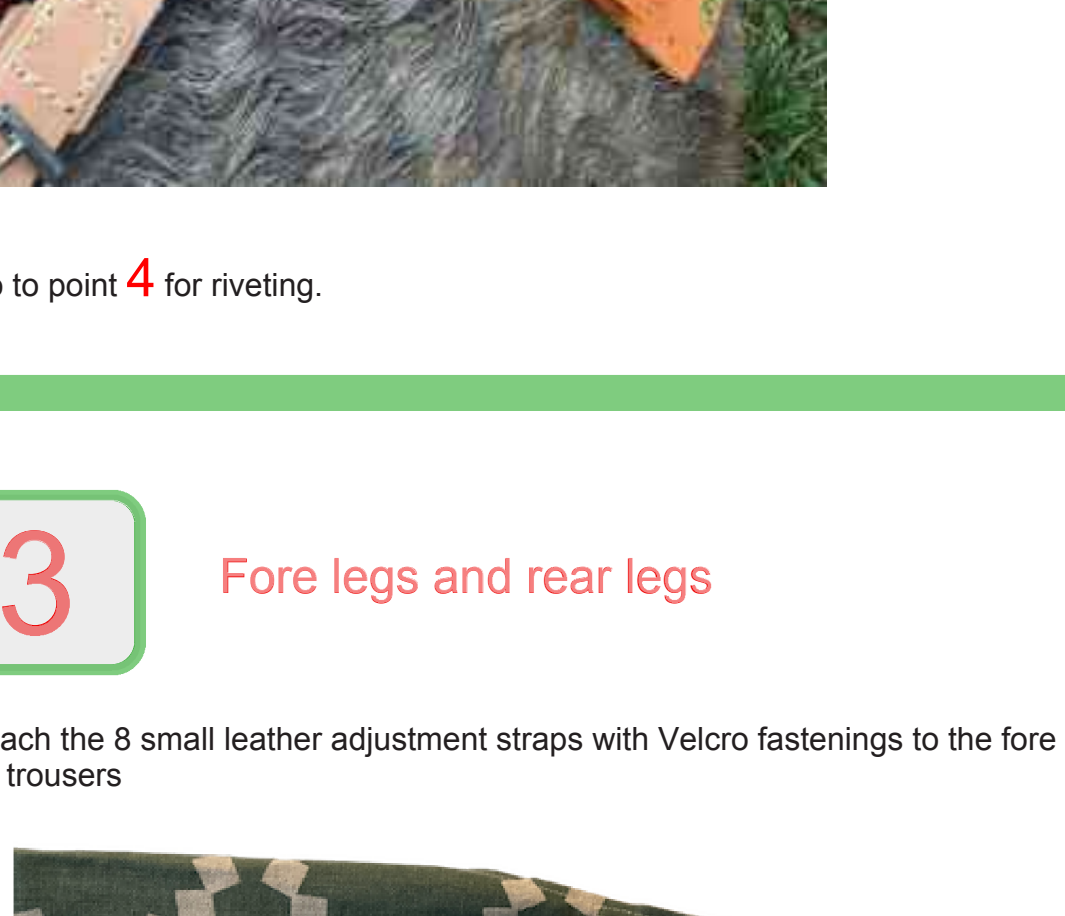
- Perform this action using the optimal 'handsome' setting.



- Go to point 4 for riveting

2 Rear legs only

- Attach the 4 small leather adjustment straps with Velcro fastenings to the trousers.

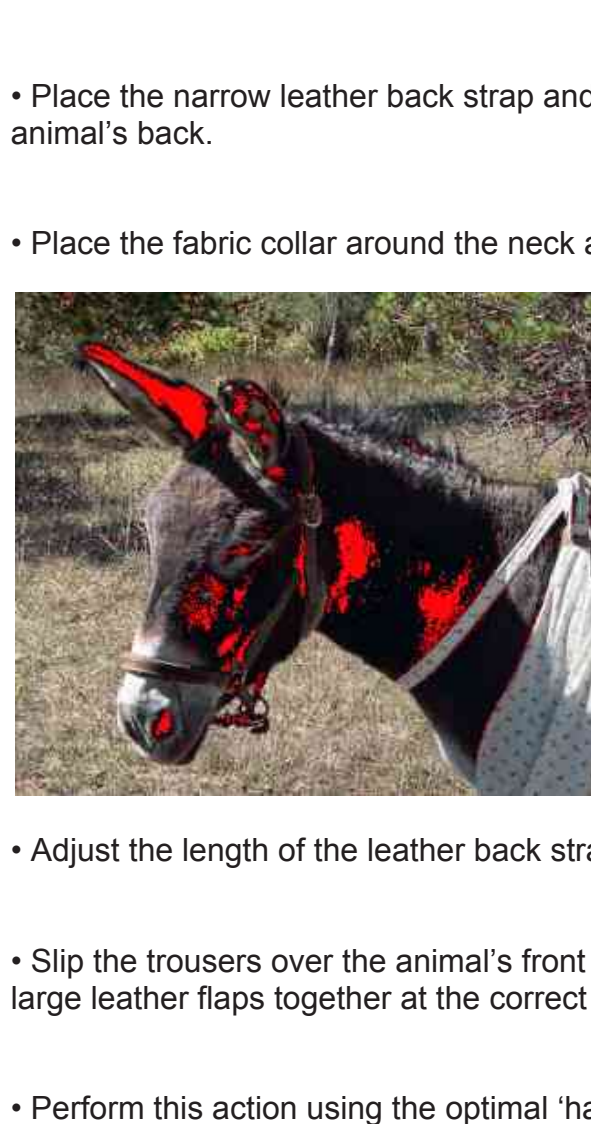


- Attach the fabric chest strap to the front of the leather back strap.



- Place the narrow leather back strap and its four leather straps on the animal's back.

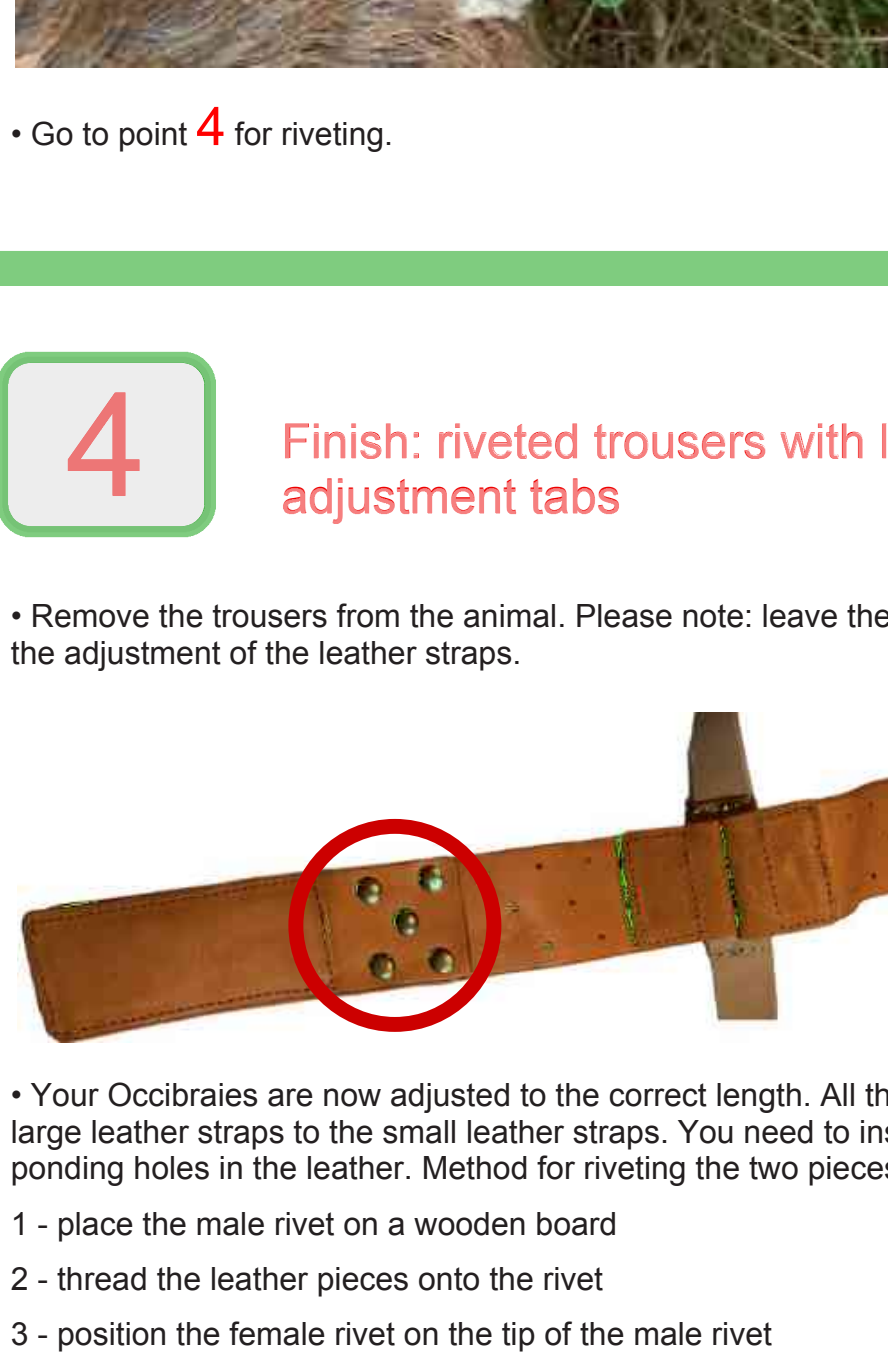
- Place the fabric collar around the neck and tie it at the front of the chest.



- Adjust the length of the leather back strap using the buckles.

- Slip the trousers over the animal's rear legs. Secure the small and large leather flaps together at the correct height using clips.

- Perform this action using the optimal 'handsome' setting.



- Go to point 4 for riveting.

3 Fore legs and rear legs

- Attach the 8 small leather adjustment straps with Velcro fastenings to the fore and rear trousers



- Attach the fabric chest strap to the front of the leather back strap.

- Place the narrow leather back strap and its 7 leather straps and the collar on the animal's back.

- Place the fabric collar around the neck and tie it at the front of the chest.

- Adjust the length of the leather back strap using the buckles.

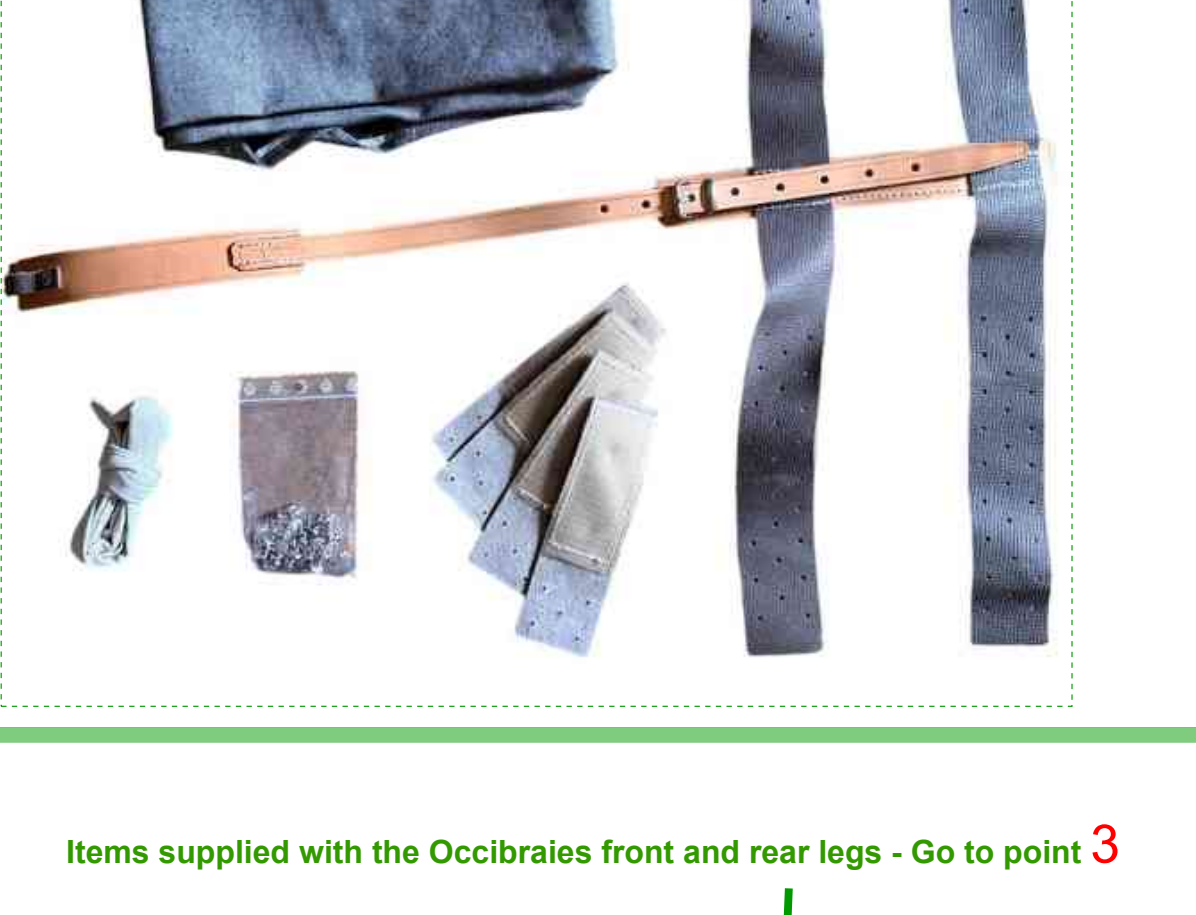
- Slip the trousers over the animal's front legs and rear legs. Secure the small and large leather flaps together at the correct height using clips.

- Perform this action using the optimal 'handsome' setting.

- Go to point 4 for riveting.

4 Finish: riveted trousers with leather adjustment tabs

- Remove the trousers from the animal. Please note: leave the clips in place to maintain the adjustment of the leather straps.



- Your Occibraies are now adjusted to the correct length. All that remains is to join the large leather straps to the small leather straps. You need to insert rivets into the corresponding holes in the leather. Method for riveting the two pieces of leather together :

- 1 - place the male rivet on a wooden board
- 2 - thread the leather pieces onto the rivet
- 3 - position the female rivet on the tip of the male rivet
- 4 - give 3 sharp taps with a hammer (no more)

- From now on, to put on the Occibraies, simply place the leather strap across your back, slip on the trousers, then fasten the trousers and the leather straps together with the Velcro.

5 Precautions

Your animal is now the most beautiful, dressed in Occibraies Randoline.

Be careful, though, not to let him wander about in his smart trousers in a field full of brambles and thorns of all kinds; he'd soon ruin all your hard work.

Please note: Spend an hour observing the animal. If it tries to get rid of the Occibraies by turning round and biting them, do not persist. It will take 5 minutes to tear them all to shreds if you let it. The donkey's whims are not covered by the warranty!

Please not also : Never leave the Occibraies on the animal overnight.
